Kennedy Jeffers of Greensboro was named a 2020 National Gold Award Girl Scout. This honor is given to 10 Girl Scouts across the United States every year. Jeffers' project focused on creating a club at her high school to support students in earning service-learning hours. The club tackled problems such as healthcare access and education, food insecurity, menstrual equality and distracted driving.

"Being a Gold Award Girl Scout really can change your life. I received more than \$300,000 in scholarships and was accepted by many of my top-choice colleges, and I'm sure that having the Gold Award on my resume and application was a big part of it! I'm currently at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte as a pre-nursing major. The fact that Girl Scouts really emphasizes improving the world around you and that service has been a big part of my Girl Scout experience inspired me to go into nursing. I hope to become a nurse practitioner and a leader in the nursing field where I can serve my community and change lives."

Kennedy founded the first service learning club at Northern Guilford High School. The club, WorldChangers Service Learning Club, worked on several different projects in its first year including creating reusable menstruation kits for girls overseas, raising awareness about homelessness in Greensboro and creating a co-hort of youth to lead the charge for change.



51,182 packages of cookies were sold and delivered to our U.S. and overseas military through Operation Sweet Treat- the highest amount ever!


- Over 15 free virtual mental health sessions for adults and children hosted on Facebook Live with our community partner, The Kellin Foundation






2017 to 2020 Total Revenue and Expense (in millions of dollars)

- Life is an adventure...not always a good one, but if you look at it this way...you can get through anything.






